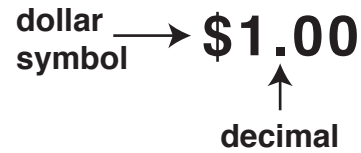


Using the dollar symbol and decimal; recognizing dollar coins and bills

Money amounts up to 99 cents are written with the cent symbol (¢).  
 When you get to 100 cents the amount is written with a dollar symbol (\$).  
 The **dollar symbol** goes in front.  
 The **decimal point** separates dollars from cents.  
 We have both dollar coins and bills.
